Dear Friends and Family,

Whilst the calendar may be telling us it is spring here in Romania, as I look out my window all I can see are gloomy grey clouds. But whilst I may not be able to see it, I know that the sun is there, somewhere. This reminds me of a beautiful hymn written by a Romanian poet, Traian Dorz, whilst he was imprisoned for his faith under communism. Roughly translated he writes "Do not doubt, but believe, after any cloud there is an even sweeter, brighter sun. Clouds are not eternal, but it is the sun that stays and triumphs". We need to trust that eventually the clouds will part and the sun will shine again. Psalms 62:8 compels us, "Trust in him at all times, you people; pour out your hearts to him, for God is our refuge." No matter what it looks like outside, or inside our hearts, we can pour out our hearts to our Father, trusting that he is our refuge. Our pray is that we can all proclaim with the psalmist, "The LORD is my strength and my shield; my heart trusts in him, and he helps me. My heart leaps for joy, and with my song I praise him" (Psalm 28:7).

We were able to attend the National conference in Sibiu on 5-6 April, where AMEC celebrated 30 years of ministry in Romania. The theme of the conference was being steadfast in a changing world. On Monday 20th April, we joined with other AMEC workers and volunteers to share the Easter message

through the story of the Good Shepard to 150 children in Jebel, a small town about 25kms south of Timisoara. Between 28th April- 3 May we are at the AMEC training centre in Sibiu for Adi to complete AMEC's second level of teacher training (PEC2). We are also in prayerful preparation and discussion about a strategic literature distribution in a northern area of Timis county, with the intention of making contacts and developing relationships with churches in that area. There is also the possibility of helping some colleagues with their vision of opening a new good news kids club in a neighbouring village. Please pray that God will guide and direct us as to where to invest our time and energy and that all we do would be for the glory of God and the proclamation of the Good News.
